### Pet of the Month - Kali



Kali came in to see George on 25<sup>th</sup> July as she was not putting any weight on her left hind leg after slipping at the bottom of the stairs. Under sedation, George was able to diagnose a ruptured cruciate ligament.

George operated on Kali on 31<sup>st</sup> July, removing damaged tissue from within Kali's knee joint and stabilising the joint with a surgical procedure known as a lateral suture.

Kali is doing incredibly well after her surgery and is now bearing weight well on her leg. Her owner is working with her to gradually rebuild the muscle in this leg.

We hope you are back to your prime soon Kali!
